COMPLIANCE

AlloSource's relationships enable access to best practices in the industry.

- Partners with Organ Procurement Organizations that provide donors through dedicated recovery processes, ensuring consistent allograft supply.
- Abides by strict donor selection and donor screening criteria, including in-depth medical and social history review and extensive serology testing.
- Maintains registrations, licenses and accreditations through organizations such as the FDA, AATB, CLIA, BSI and additional state and international regulatory bodies.*



SAFETY

AlloSource has never had a confirmed incidence of disease transmission since its inception.

- Controls the tissue from receipt of donation to distribution to customers.
- Performs thorough donor assessment, microbiological testing and various disinfection processes.
- Ensures aseptically processed tissue is evaluated for contamination and meets rigorous specification requirements.
- Confirms terminally sterilized tissue yields a sterility assurance level equivalent to medical devices, without impacting the structural integrity, quality and performance of the tissue.



MANUFACTURING

AlloSource operates out of a 160,000-square-foot facility in Centennial, Colorado, complete with 37 state-of-the-art, ISO Class 5 clean rooms and a central services department.

- Develops technicians who are experts in processing specific tissue types including skin, cartilage, soft tissue and bone graft processing in a continuous 365-day operation.
- Follows validated and controlled manufacturing procedures unique to each product.
- Uses cutting edge equipment to drive quality and new allograft technologies.

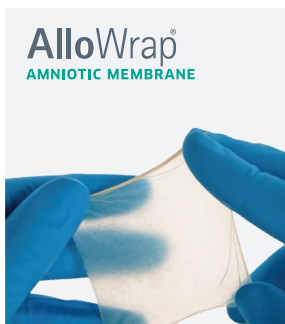
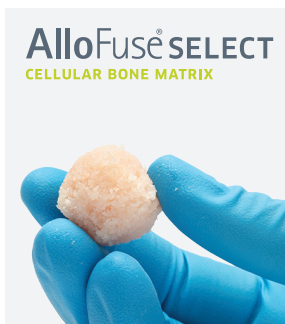
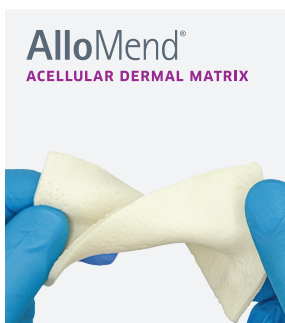


INNOVATION

PROCESSES

AlloSource has developed proprietary processes including:

- **AlloTrue®** - automated cleansing process for tendons and bone grafts.
- **DermaTrue®** - dermal tissue decellularization process used to remove cellular debris while preserving tissue structure and crucial proteins.
- **ViaTrue®** - unique cartilage cryopreservation process that preserves chondrocyte viability.
